

## Guidelines for University of Idaho TEMPORARY Disability Permits

As of September 1, 2008, University of Idaho disability permits must be displayed in conjunction with a state-issued temporary or permanent disability permit on campus.

### Temporary UI Disability Permits:

- Temporary disability permits are available for purchase for \$1.00/day
- 1 – 3 day disability permits are available for purchase without doctor's consent, limit is one per academic year
- 4 to 90 day temporary disability permits can be purchased with doctor's consent and completion of a temporary disability permit application, once all 90 days have been issued additional days may only be given if a new injury occurs
- Temporary permits are valid only for dates stamped on permit, permit is invalid if altered in any way, altering permit constitutes illegal use
- Only valid on the University of Idaho campus

Vehicles displaying a University of Idaho temporary Disability permit may park in any of the following locations. These areas are prioritized as listed; prioritizing parking areas is an attempt to maintain the oversized spaces for those with special needs, such as van lifts and wheelchair users.

1. Any regular space in any colored lot
2. Designated Disability parking spaces
3. Designated "Valid Campus Walkway Permit Required" spaces on the walkway

Disability permits are **Not Valid** in any of the following locations. Parking in these areas may result in a citation and/or a fine.

1. Service / Delivery spaces
2. Reserved spaces, designated by signage
3. All other areas not designated as a parking space (fire lane, yellow curb, etc...)
4. Parking overnight in areas posted "No Parking 2 a.m. to 6 a.m."

Idaho Code Title 49-177.7b:

“Person with a disability” means:

- (i) A person who is unable to walk two hundred (200) feet or more unassisted by another person;
- (ii) A person who is unable to walk two hundred (200) feet or more without the aid of a walker, cane, crutches, braces, prosthetic device or a wheelchair; or
- (iii) A person who is unable to walk two hundred (200) feet or more without great difficulty or discomfort due to the following impairments: neurological, orthopedic, respiratory, cardiac, arthritic disorder, blindness, or the loss of function or absence of a limb.
