

Guidelines for Use of Vendor Permits At the University of Idaho

- Vendor permits are intended for work related use by individuals who provide services to the University of Idaho and are **not directly employed by the University of Idaho**
- Vendor permits are not valid for individuals who spend all working hours in an office located on campus
- Vendor permits are not intended for UI employees or students for work related or personal use

Vehicles displaying a valid University of Idaho Vendor permit may park in any of the following locations. These parking areas are prioritized as listed.

1. Any regular space in any colored lot
2. Designated “valid campus walkway” spaces on walkway (30 min max)
3. Meters / timed spaces (2 hours max)

Vendor permits are **Not Valid** in any of the following locations. Parking in these areas may result in a citation and/or a fine.

1. Service / Delivery spaces
2. Disability spaces
3. Reserved spaces
4. All other areas not designated as a parking space (fire lane, yellow curb, etc...)
5. Areas posted “No parking 2 a.m. to 6 a.m.”
